

4th Annual Re-Purposed Doodad Sculpture Competition

Competition Guidelines *(revised 02/10/15)*

BACKGROUND

Hillsborough County Public Schools continues our partnership with the Tampa Regional Artists to provide students with the opportunity to recycle and re-purpose a new object! Starting in 2011, plastic street globes from the Horizon Bay at Hyde Park assisted living retirement community were re-purposed by Hillsborough County students and transformed in creative sculptures. This tradition lives on!

GUIDELINES

ACCEPTED	NOT ACCEPTED
Any kind and amount of plastic bottles & any amount of throw beads strands	includes no plastic bottle or throw beads
individual & group work	majority of work completed by teacher or other adult(s)
in-the-round sculptures no bigger than 4' square	hangs from ceiling
low or high relief sculptures	requires electricity
wall sculptures have sturdy wire attached and is ready to hang on wall	relief sculptures have poor method to hang or is not ready to hang on wall
weighs under 50 lbs	weighs over 50 lbs
well-crafted sculptures	poorly crafted sculptures or over sized
bottles, beads and enhancements are SECURELY attached	bottles secured poorly and attachments falling off
stable sculptures	unstable and/or unbalanced sculpture
bottles can be taken apart, drilled, sawed, painted and assembled with other re-purposed objects	other re-purposed objects make up the majority of the sculpture instead of the bottles and throw beads
original sculptures	plagiarized work or work that violates copyright laws
fits into one of the themed categories	totally unrelated to any of the themed categories
student(s) included an artist statement	student(s) did NOT include an artist statement
