

# 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Re-Purposed Doodad Sculpture Competition

## Competition Guidelines *(revised 05/10/16)*

### BACKGROUND

Hillsborough County Public Schools continues our partnership with the Tampa Regional Artists to provide students with the opportunity to recycle and re-purpose a new object! Starting in 2011, plastic street globes from the Horizon Bay at Hyde Park assisted living retirement community were re-purposed by Hillsborough County students and transformed in creative sculptures. This tradition lives on!

### GUIDELINES

ACCEPTED	NOT ACCEPTED
Any kind and amount of paper plus binder (tape, glue, flour & water, etc.). Paper can include cardboard, newspaper, books, magazines, copy paper, origami paper, tissue paper, wallpaper etc. Armatures must also be made of paper.	Objects or materials other than paper used which includes foam core, plastic, metal, wood, wire, or any other non-paper material.
paint or other colorant can be used on surface	uses non-paper materials on surface
individual & group work	majority of work completed by teacher or other adult(s)
in-the-round sculptures no bigger than 4' square	sculptures beyond the size limit
low or high relief wall sculptures	hangs from ceiling or requires electricity
wall sculptures have sturdy wire attached and is ready to hang on wall	wall sculptures have poor method to hang from wall or is not ready to hang on wall
weighs under 50 lbs	weighs over 50 lbs
well-crafted sculptures	poorly crafted sculptures and falling apart
stable sculptures	unstable and/or unbalanced sculptures
original sculptures	plagiarized work or work that violates copyright laws
fits into one of the themed categories	totally unrelated to any of the themed categories
student(s) included an artist statement	student(s) did <b>NOT</b> include an artist statement
