

6th Annual Re-Purposed Doodad Sculpture Competition

Competition Guidelines *(revised 11/15/16)*

BACKGROUND

Hillsborough County Public Schools continues our partnership with the Tampa Regional Artists to provide K-12 students in public, private, charter or homeschool with the opportunity to recycle and re-purpose an object! Starting in 2011, plastic street globes from the Horizon Bay at Hyde Park assisted living retirement community were re-purposed by Hillsborough County students and transformed in creative sculptures. This tradition lives on!

GUIDELINES

ACCEPTED	NOT ACCEPTED
One or more legally obtained campaign signs must be used. Some part of the actual sign must be visible. Any and all parts of sign may be used including the sign itself, and the material used to display the sign.	Illegally obtained campaign signs are used, or no part of actual sign is visible.
Other materials may be used; however, majority of sculpture must be constructed of campaign sign material.	majority of sculpture is constructed of non-campaign sign material
individual & group work with majority of sculpture designed and created by students	majority of work completed by teacher or other adult(s)
In-the-round sculptures are no larger than 3 feet x 3 feet x 4 feet	sculpture beyond size limit
low or high relief wall sculptures	hangs from ceiling or requires electricity
wall sculptures have sturdy wire attached and is ready to hang on wall	wall sculptures have poor method to hang from wall or isn't ready to hang on wall
weighs under 50 lbs	weighs over 50 pounds
well-crafted sculptures	poorly crafted sculptures or falling apart
stable sculptures	unstable and/or unsteady sculptures
original sculptures	plagiarized work or work that violates copyright laws
fits into one of the themed categories	totally unrelated to any of the themed categories
student(s) included an artist statement	student(s) did NOT include an artist statement
